Greg Kaul & Company 1987 Butte Note

I'm Greg Kaul and my last position before retirement was Sr. HSSE Operations Specialist / HSSE Initiatives Advisor. At the time of this writing, I was the Maintenance foreman on the Butte System from 1983 to 1988 stationed in Baker, Montana.

One of my fondest memories came on August 13, 2008, I was called by Doug Havens, one of my former lead men. He was so excited I had to get him to stop and take a breath to compose himself and tell me about all the excitement.

When Doug worked with me on the Butte Pipeline System in Montana and Wyoming some 21 years earlier we did a job out on the main line that required us to dig up the pipeline in the middle of nowhere and see what the issue was with the Catholic protection and test lead connections. A 4" steel post approximately 8 feet to the north of the test lead had a higher potential than the test lead. So we dug it up to find a buried 2" valve inside of a protective barrier and the 4" steel post was the marker. This was not on the pipeline alignment sheets from original construction.

So to mark the occasion, we emptied out salsa jar wrapped it in duct tape and buried a time capsule. At the time, we would have never thought this system would be sold to another company and someone other than a Shell employee would find it.

To my astonishment that day came and became one of the biggest talking points with the new company.

I have attached a copy of the original document that was buried in the salsa jar, not sure who got the money but it has all the names of the pipe liners who participated in the dig
