Hobbs employees haven't had an OSHA recordable or a lost-time incident since 1988. Among the systems operated by the Denver City work group is the 30-inch Cortez CO2 pipeline. The 23 employees in this group haven't had an OSHA recordable incident since 1987.

In the Midland Area Office, 28 employees help manage Shell Pipe Line operations for the West Texas Area, which includes West Texas, New Mexico, Colorado, Montana and Wyoming. The 10 employees at Odessa operate crude lines feeding the Odessa Refinery and the start of the six-inch products pipeline to El Paso.

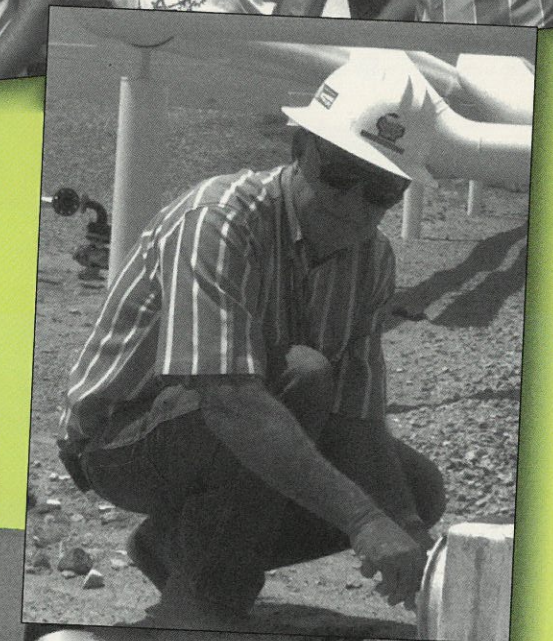
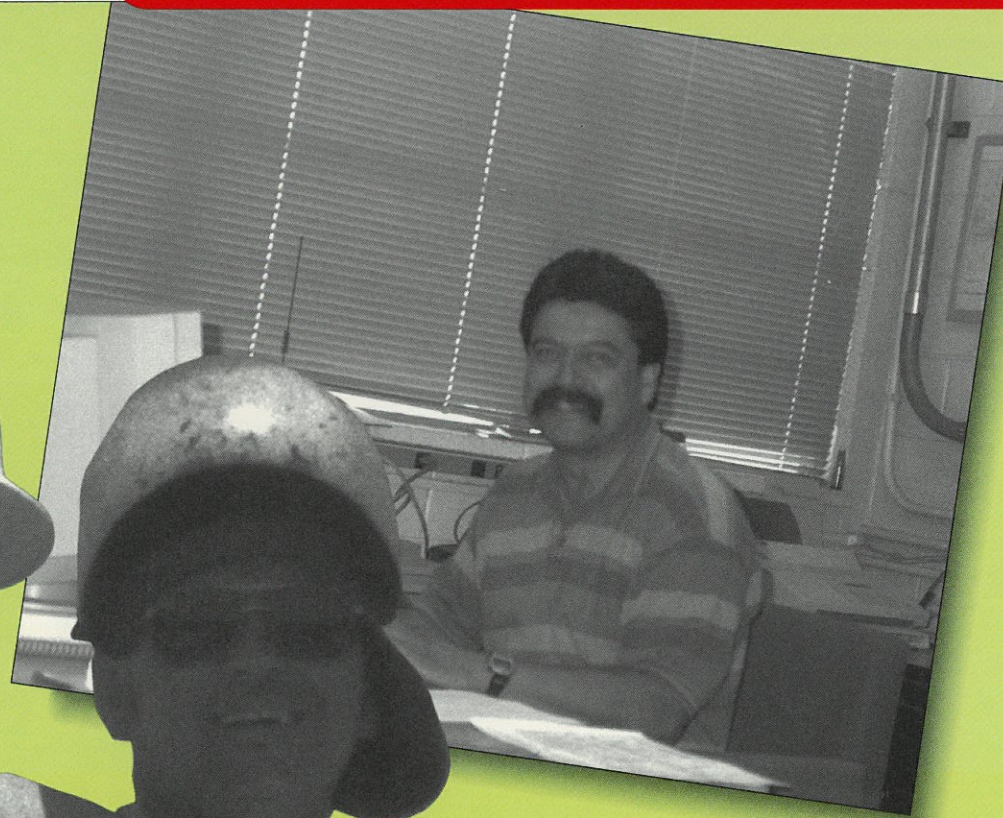
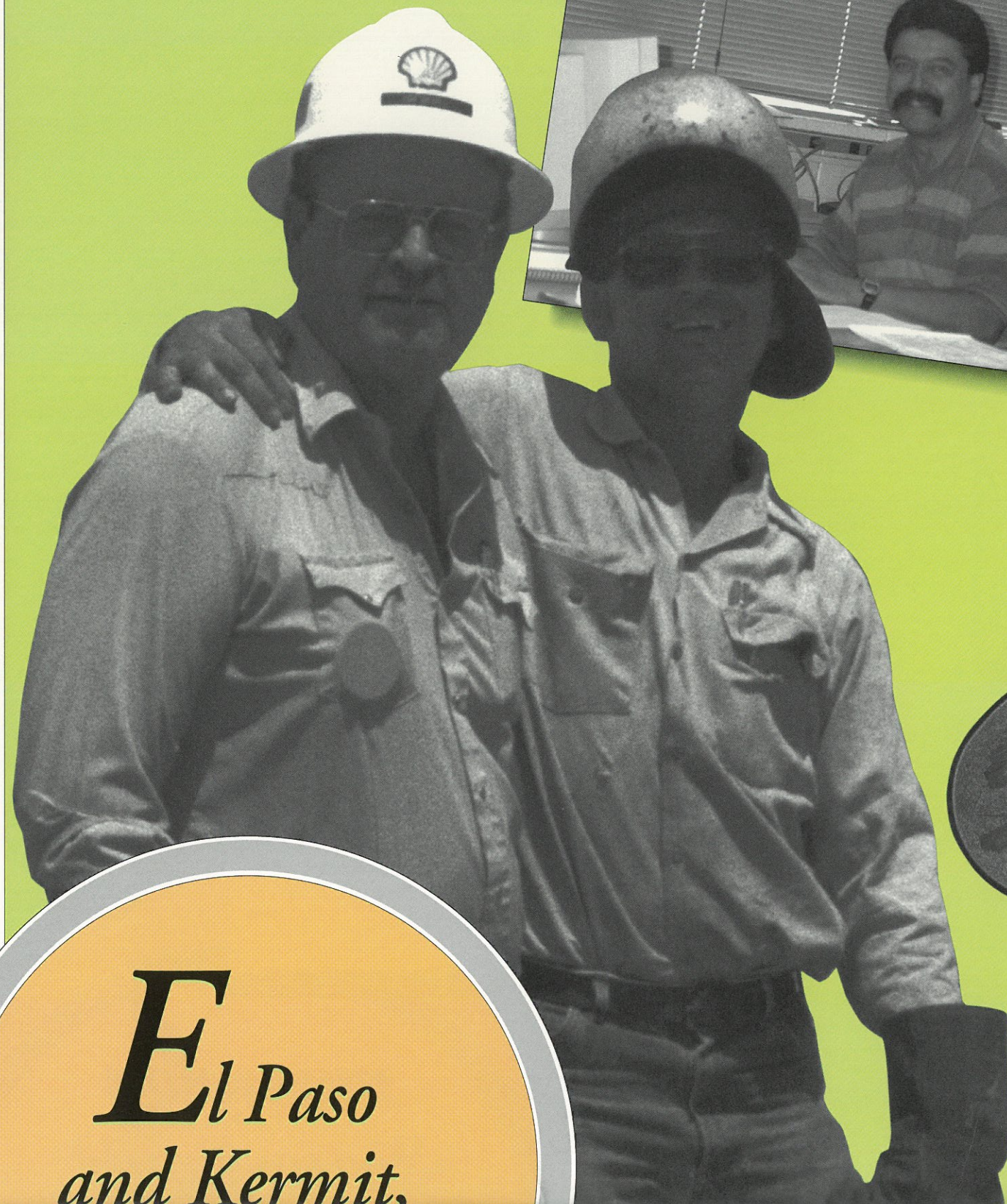

Sorrento is the site of Shell Pipe Line's five salt dome storage wells. The 26 employees in the Sorrento/Napoleonville group last had a lost-time incident in December 1981. The 27 Shell Pipe Line employees at Norco are responsible for operating pipelines that transport a wide variety of petroleum products and chemicals, including crude oil, gasoline, furnace oil, jet fuel, butane, propane, ethane, ethylene and propylene. That group hasn't had a lost-time incident or preventable auto accident since 1990.

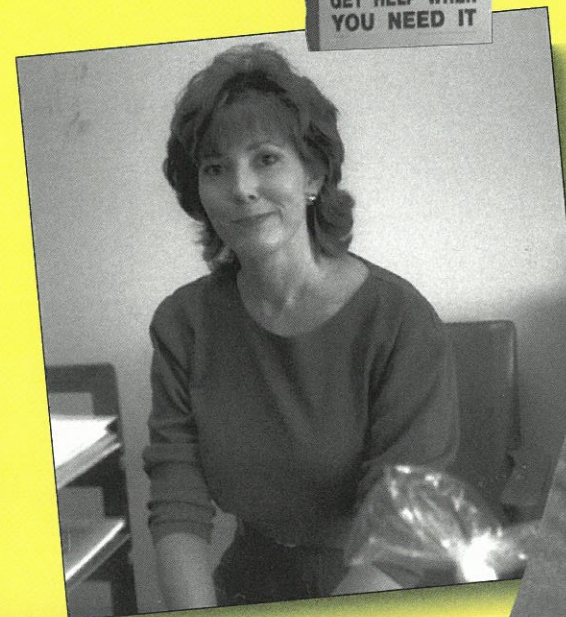
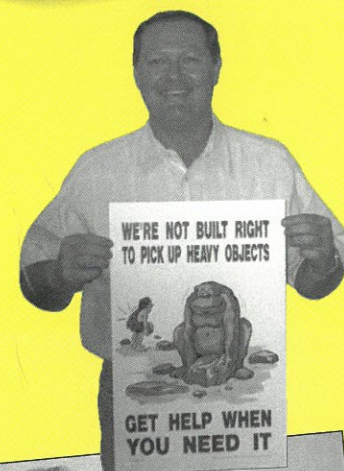
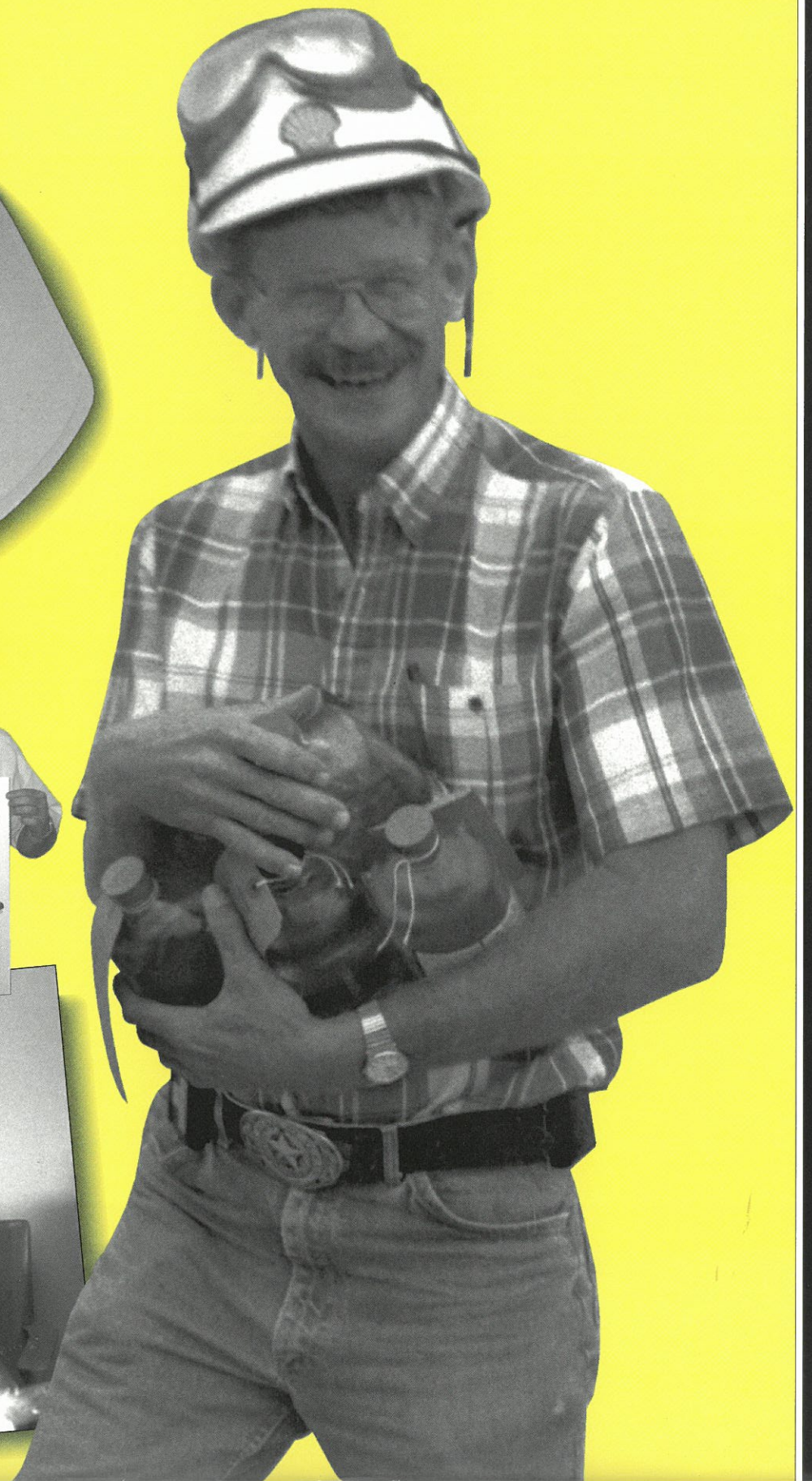


Working just a few miles from the Texas-Mexico border, the seven employees at Shell Pipe Line's El Paso location are responsible for operating the end of the Odessa-El Paso six-inch products pipeline. Each day, the pipeline transports 18,000 barrels of either gasoline, diesel or aviation fuel. Employees at El Paso haven't had a preventable auto accident since February 1991. The 12 employees at the Hendrick Tank Farm near Kermit, Texas, are responsible for 12 storage tanks, 130 miles of six-inch products line and pump stations.

St. James is the originating terminal for the 40-inch Capline Pipeline—one of the largest diameter pipelines in the continental United States. The facility is located on the site where the first Acadian settlers arrived in Louisiana from France in 1756. The settlement was named after their leader, Jacques Cantrelle Sr., and later took on the English name of St. James. The 31 employees at St. James haven't experienced a preventable auto accident since 1991.

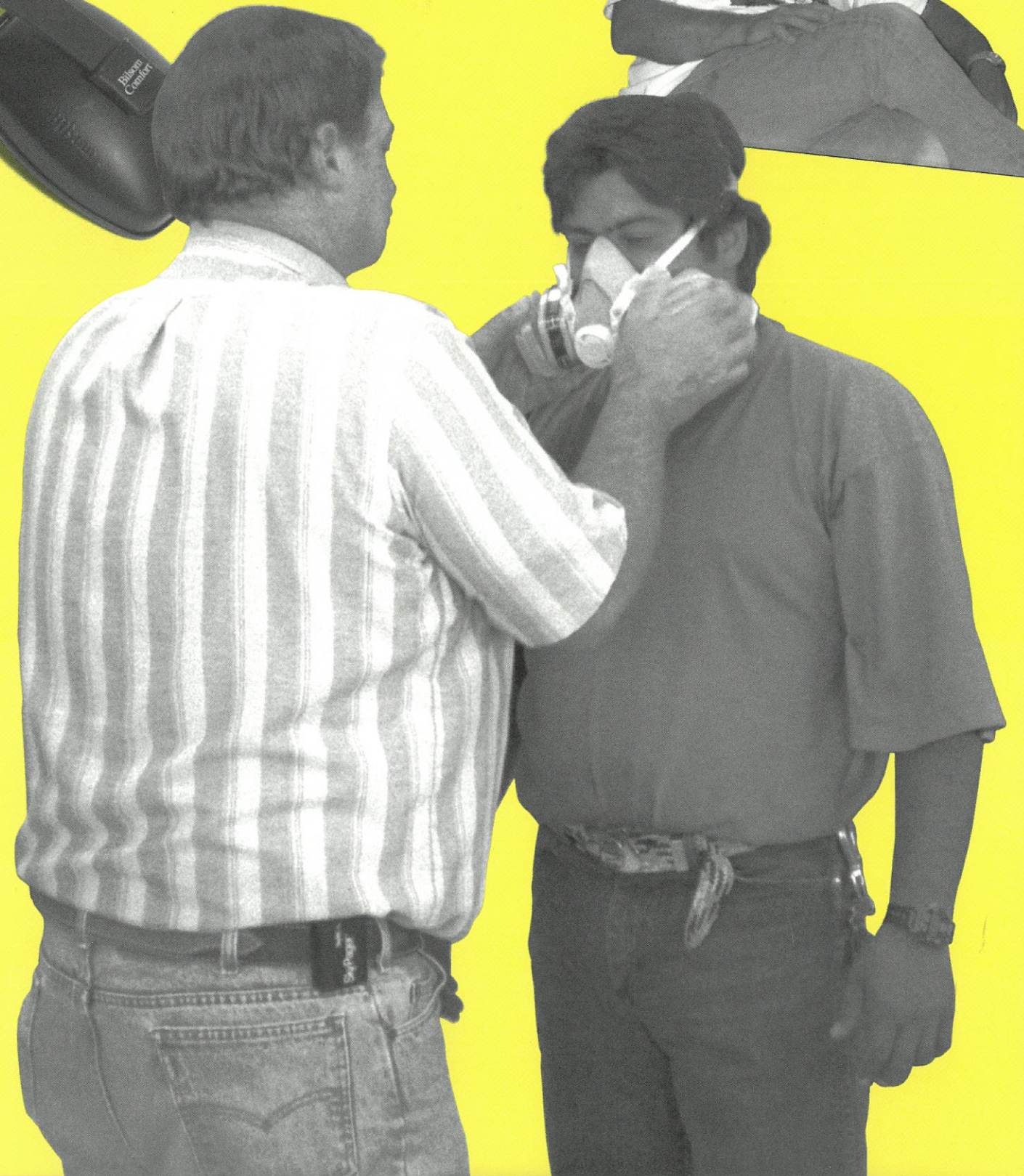
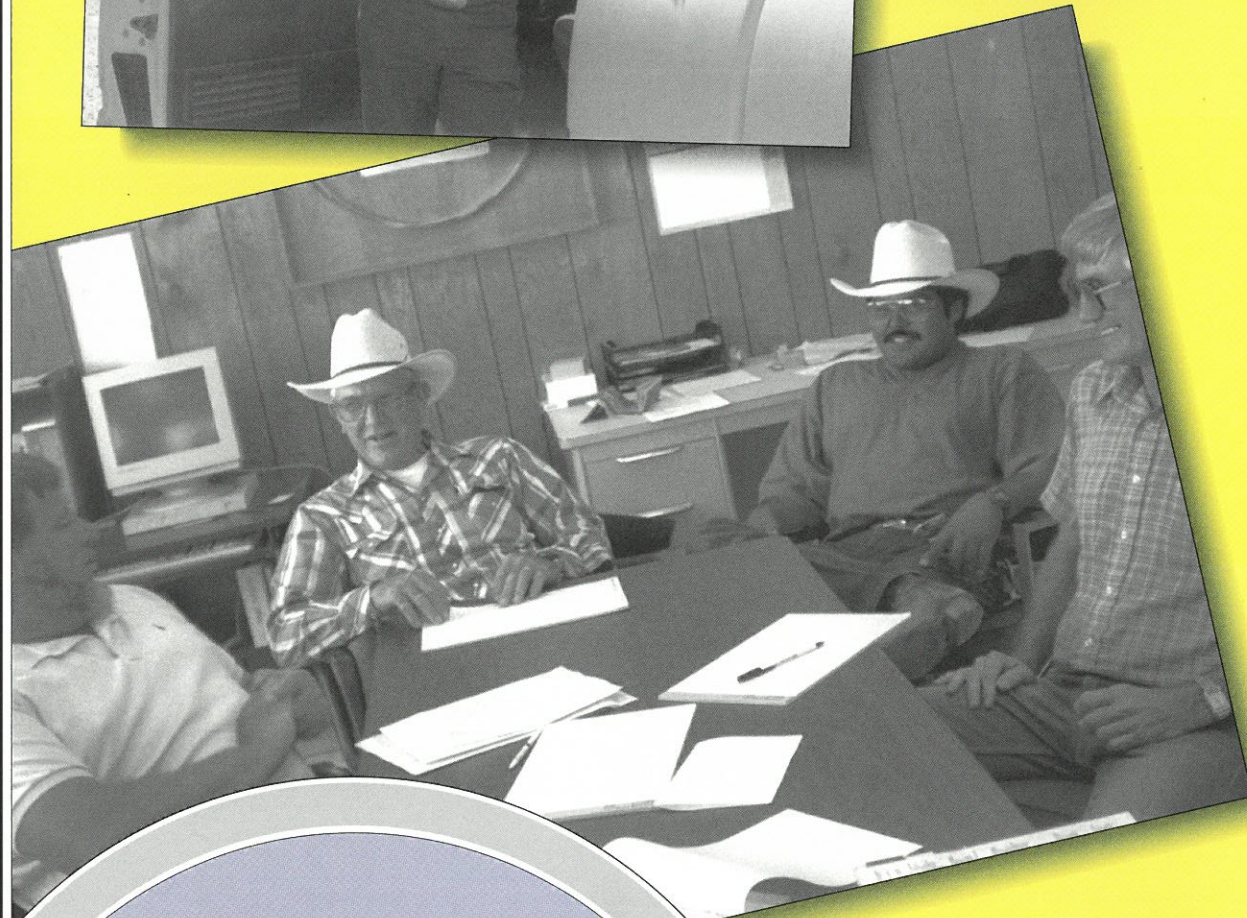
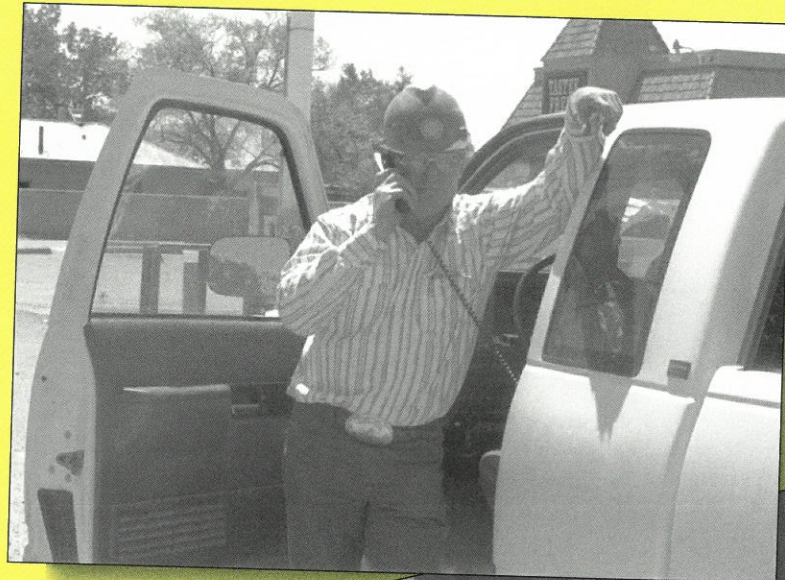

A lot of emergency response equipment is stored at the Paducah office, which is located near the Ohio River crossing as well as the New Madrid fault. For employees at the Memphis office, soil erosion in the Mississippi area provides a constant challenge. Each office is responsible for maintaining four Capline pump stations.

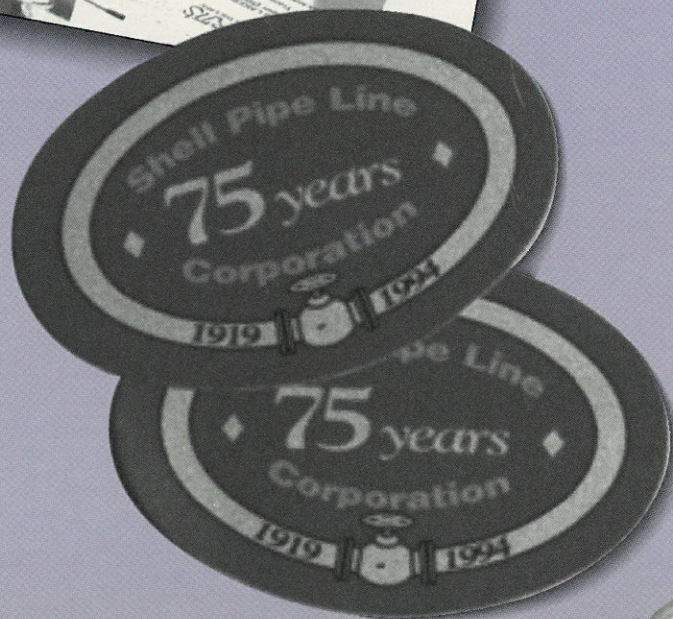
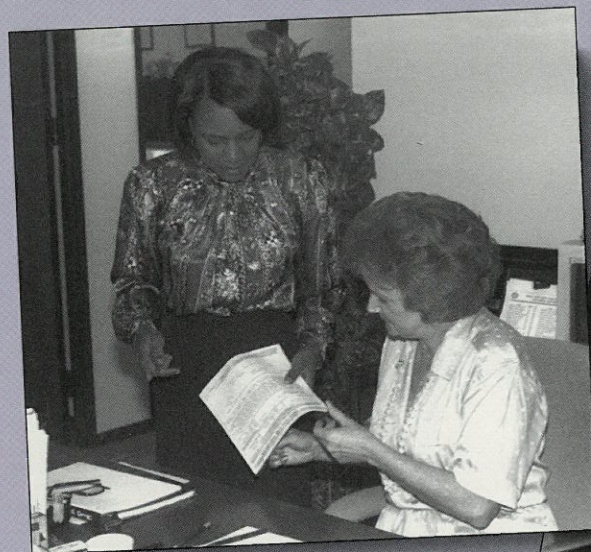


Located near the centuries-old Anasazi Indian ruins, Shell Pipe Line's Cortez facility is staffed by four employees who operate the north end of the 30-inch Cortez CO2 Pipeline. It's not uncommon to spot deer and elk grazing on the right-of-way for this pipeline, which moves carbon dioxide southeast to Texas for enhancing oil recovery. The three employees at Edgewood, New Mexico, maintain the central portion of the Cortez pipeline. Employees in both groups have worked since 1990 without experiencing an OSHA recordable incident.

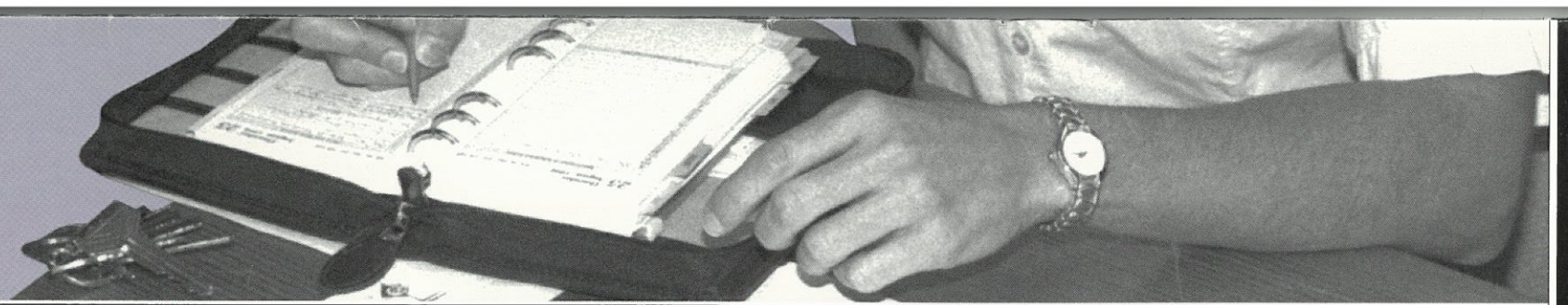
